Dear Doctor:

Thank you for your interest in applying for an American College of Mohs Surgery (ACMS) fellowship Director, Associate Director, Surgical Faculty or Senior Faculty position. Below you will find an outline of the core competencies that the Site Inspection & Slide Review Board looks for when reviewing a program, which will help you with your application.

- Completed application form including application fee
- Curriculum Vitae: Recent research (past five years) in Mohs Surgery and Cutaneous Oncology, published in peer-reviewed journals.
- Fellowship Training Program Number of Cases Form (Director application only)
- Fellow schedule/curriculum (Director application only)
- Regular attendance at ACMS annual meeting (required of Director, reviewed for all)
- Case log: Number of Mohs cases
 - Program: 500 per year for one-year program, 300 per year for two-year program (600 total cases required for fellows in two-year programs)
 - Director: Minimum 300 per year for one or two-year program. If no Associate Director, Surgical or Senior Faculty apply, the requirement is 500 cases per year for a one-year program and 300 per year for a two-year program.
 - Associate Director: Same as Director
 - Surgical Faculty: 200 per year
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
- Case Log: Complex Mohs cases (per page 2 of PPG)
 - Director: 50 per year
 - Associate Director: 50 per year
 - Surgical Faculty: No requirement
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
- Case Log: Complex reconstructions (per page 2 of PPG)
 - Director: 50 per year
 - Associate Director: 50 per year
 - Surgical Faculty: No requirement
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
- Case Log: Tumor variety (required of Director)
 - Melanomas
 - Dermatofibrosarcoma Protuberans
 - Merkel cell carcinoma
 - Atypical fibroxanthoma
 - Malignant Fibrous histiocytoma
 - Sebaceous carcinoma
 - Extra mammary Paget's disease
