Thank you for your interest in applying for an international American College of Mohs Surgery (ACMS) Micrographic Surgery & Dermatologic Oncology (Mohs) Program Director, Associate Director, Surgical Faculty or Senior Faculty position. Below you will find an outline of the core competencies that the Site Inspection & Slide Review Board (SISRB) requires, which will help you with your application.

- Completed application form including application fee
- Curriculum Vitae: Recent research (past five years) in Micrographic Surgery and Dermatologic Oncology, published in peer-reviewed journals.
- Regular attendance at the ACMS Annual Meeting.
- Case log:
 - Director: 1000 dermatologic surgical procedures; At least 650 of that minimum total must be Micrographic Surgery & Dermatologic Oncology (Mohs) procedures per 12-month program
 - Associate Director: Same as Director
 - Surgical Faculty: 200 per 12-month program
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
- Case Log: Complex Mohs cases (per page 2 of the Policies, Procedures, & Guidelines)
 - Director: 50 per 12-month program
 - Associate Director: 50 per 12-month program
 - Surgical Faculty: No requirement
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
- Case Log: Complex reconstructions (per page 2 of the Policies, Procedures, & Guidelines)
 - Director: 50 per 12-month program
 - Associate Director: 50 per 12-month program
 - Surgical Faculty: No requirement
 - Senior Faculty: No requirement
