Thank you for your interest in applying for an international American College of Mohs Surgery (ACMS) Micrographic Surgery & Dermatologic Oncology (Mohs) Program Director, Associate Director, Surgical Faculty or Senior Faculty position. Below you will find an outline of the core competencies that the Site Inspection & Slide Review Board (SISRB) requires, which will help you with your application.

Note for Director applications: It typically takes six to 12 months to gather the necessary information and complete the Director Application. After the submission of the application, it may take six to 12 months for the Fellowship Training Committee to make an approval decision regarding the Directors application. If a program has a tight accreditation timeline, contact ACMS/SISRB staff (sisrb@mohscollege.org) well in advance of the application submission to discuss the review timeline.
