



## ACMS FOUNDATION GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

Approved by the ACMS Board of Directors - May 1, 2019

### ACMS Board of Directors

- The Foundation is a Board directed fund/activity
- Approve/advise the plans of the Fundraising Committee
- All distributions from the Foundation are at the sole discretion of the Board and will be made by the Board with recommendations from the Governance and Policy Committee
- Yearly, the Board will give guidance as to the Board-determined priorities for funding
- Yearly, the Board will be asked to grant up to \$30,000 for operating expenses to the Foundation, with additional expenses expected to be charged against funds raised

### Fundraising Committee (chaired by Barry Leshin, 2017-2021)

- Develops processes and procedures for fundraising to support the Foundation
- Coordinates with the Governance and Policy Committee
- Reports to the Board of Directors

### Governance and Policy Committee (chaired by Tom Stasko, 2018-2021)

- Coordinates with the Fundraising Committee
- Reports to the Board of Directors
- Makes recommendations to the Board as to the funds available for distribution
- Informs the Research Grant Committee and the Mohs Development Awards Review Committee as to the funds likely available for distribution
- Makes yearly recommendations to the BOD for the distribution of funds based on the recommendations of the Research Grant Committee and the Mohs Development Awards Review Committee

### Research Grant Review Committee (chaired by Jerry Brewer, 2019-2021)

- Reports to the Governance and Policy Committee
- Develops process and procedures for the solicitation and evaluation of requests for research grants
- Makes yearly recommendations to the Governance and Policy Committee for the distribution of funds

### Mohs Development Awards Review Committee (chaired by Nat Jellinek, 2019-2021)

- Reports to the Governance and Policy Committee
- Develops process and procedures for the solicitation and evaluation of requests for grants regarding member education (including annual meeting lectures), travel awards, patient education, and all non-research related activities
- Makes yearly recommendations to the Governance and Policy Committee for the distribution of funds

### Committee makeup:

#### General principles

1. A mix of academic and private practice
2. A mix of young and more established members
3. A fellow/recently-out-of-training representative for the Research Grant Review Committee and the Mohs Development Awards Review Committee
4. Board representation on each committee, either by membership or liaison

## ACMS FOUNDATION GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

### Committee specific:

#### Fundraising Committee

6 members, including Chair

- Chair—appointed by the EC of the Board
- Committee members subject to appointment and approval by the ACMS President
- Committee members, including Chair, with staggered terms (Chair and 1 member 4 years, 2 members 3 years, 2 members 2 years)
- If no committee member is a member of the Board, a non-voting Board liaison will be appointed

#### Governance and Policy Committee

5 members

- Chair—appointed by the EC of the Board—3 year term
- At large members—2—appointed by the EC of the Board—3-year terms staggered with the Chair
- Chair of the Research Grant Review Committee
- Chair of the Mohs Development Awards Review Committee
- If no committee member is a member of the Board, a non-voting Board liaison will be appointed
- If no committee member is a member of the Fundraising Committee, a non-voting liaison will be appointed
- Governance and Policy Committee members subject to appointment and approval by the ACMS President

#### Research Grant Review Committee

5 members

- Chair- 2 year term
- Vice Chair-2 year term followed by 2 years as chair
- 3 members with staggered terms (1 for 2 years, 1 for 3 years, 1 for 4 years)
- 1 newer member (1-5 years out of fellowship training) will be appointed and will remain on the committee for two years
- If no committee member is a member of the Board, a non-voting Board liaison will be appointed
- If certain expertise is required to review grant applications, (e.g., statistics), an additional committee member with that expertise may be added for a shorter term at the request of the Chair and at the discretion of the ACMS President
- Research Grant Review Committee members subject to appointment and approval by the ACMS President

#### Mohs Development Awards Review Committee

5 members

- Chair- 2 year term
- Vice Chair-2 year term followed by 2 years as chair
- 3 members with staggered terms (1 for 2 years, 1 for 3 years, 1 for 4 years)
- 1 newer member (1-5 years out of fellowship training) will be appointed and will remain on the committee for two years
- If no committee member is a member of the Board, a non-voting Board liaison will be appointed
- If certain expertise is required to review grant applications, (e.g., statistics), an additional committee member with that expertise may be added for a shorter term at the request of the Chair and the discretion of the ACMS President
- Mohs Development Awards Review Committee members subject to appointment and approval by the ACMS President
